



## Report of the chairman of the Judging Committee 2021

### International judging list

The international judging list was not updated for 2021, as the panel of judges for 2020 was postponed to 2021. A 2022 list will be published after the plenary.

### Reminder: Judges selection for 2020

The judging process was setted as followed:

After JC received all the judges applications, the selection was made with:

- Stage #1: selection by a "selected" or "not selected" for each application by the 6 members of the JC. With 4 "not selected", the application was rejected ;

- Stage #2: each member of the JC had to select the judges with a ranking choice, for each group.

The final selection was sent to delegates or judges (when the email address was known).

- Stage #3 (late adaptation): no stage #3 in 2020, due to Covid crisis early in the year, and the postponement of all international contests.

### **Covid crisis / NAC problems: Consequences**

Due to travel problem (Covid restriction) and postpone of dates and location, the JC had to lately deal with:

- WAAC:
  - New chief-judge, in accordance with the Bureau ;
  - Panel of judges: 7 to 6 ;
  - One exchange for two judges between 2 contests ;
  - 3 withdrawals ;
  - Find 2 new judges.
- WGAC-WAGAC:
  - New chief-judge, in accordance with the Bureau ;
  - One exchange for two judges between 2 contests.
- EAC: Canceled, but initially with a lot of changes.
- E+IAC:
  - Panel of judges set from 7 to 5 by the Bureau ;
  - One judge in addition at the end, final judge panel: 6 ;
  - 1 withdrawal.

All the contests were run, from the JC point of view, in accordance with:

- FAI / CIVA Code 6 ;
- Majority of the Judging Committee for all decisions ;
- adaptation to a constantly changing situation.
