IT PROJECTS

Projects support

- Maintaining reduced fixed cost expense levels
- Implementing efficiency gains
- Maintaining service levels
- Supporting lower staffing levels in Secretariat

Main activities

FAI PAYHUB API (LONG-TERM ACTIVITY BEGAN 2022, INITIAL APPROVAL GC 2021)

PayHub Objectives

- A "web shop" for immaterial goods like sanction fees, record fees, sporting licences etc.
- Automatic invoice and payment synchronization with RmA.
- No need to create invoices manually or to book payments.
- Make it easy to collect non-recurring payments.
- Possible to connect any (FAI) system to PayHub payments.

Features

- Integrate all incoming online payments to PayHub
- Single point of management
 - Example, 2024 Swiss VAT change implemented via PayHub rather per application
- All invoices managed from single application
- Real Time integration with RmA (accounting)
- Reporting
- Excel exports of orders
- Statistics

API = application programming interface



EXTRANET SECURITY UPDATE (APPROVAL GC 2022)

- Extranet = Sporting Licenses, CIAM Judges, CIAM Experts, Delegates tool)
- Objectives
 - Laravel-framework with increased security levels and supporting future developments
 - Remove weak passwords
 - PHP update (practically all FAI applications are programmed in PHP)
 - Additional tools for statistics and reporting
- Situation
 - New version launched October 2023 (PoC: it@fai.org)
 - All old passwords were renewed
 - Small changes in end-user interface
 - New features in Administrator interface
 - Search functionality
 - Reporting



MAIN DATABASE API DEVELOPMENT

- **Main FAI databases** = intranet databases
 - members, organisations, records, events, awards, persons, meetings etc
- Practically all FAI main databases can now be accessed from other applications through APIs
- Simple API rights management site to manage what other applications can see and do
- Used by new and existing IT development projects
- Logging of all API transactions
- Examples: 45'527 persons (w/o SL holders), 27'192 events



FAI STATISTICS (IT ENVIRONMENT)

- 3.8 TB of documents on office shared drives
- Over 200 mailing lists
- 3'500 mailing list subscriptions
- Over 1'000 individual subscribers on the mailing list
- 100 user accounts on the cloud server
- 6 physical servers divided into 50 virtual servers
- Main database examples
 - 45'527 persons (w/o SL holders), 27'192 events, 1'868 organizations
- SL database
 - 124'792 persons and 364'763 licences (29'290 currently valid)



FAI IT PROJECTS (REMAINDER OF 2023 / BEGINNING OF 2024)

- From budget 2023 approval by GC 2022
- Financial Expenditure approval (EB) on 19 Sep 2023

- **PayPal payments development**
 - Supporting credit card payment, Reducing manual work creating invoices
- **Record Application development**
 - Document (dossiers) upload and management
 - Note: preliminary claim upload (budget 2023) to be launched YE 2023
- **Officials Management**
 - ASC officials management tool (elected officials, SC-/WG-members) -> prime users = Commission Secretaries
 - Implementation phase -> launch planned 2024

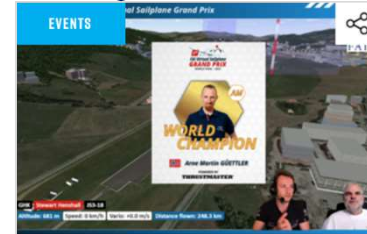

Namwon, Korea, 10 October 2023 – The 2023 FAI World Drone Racing Championship (WDRC) came to a close yesterday after four days of thrilling competition in Namwon, Korea. This prestigious competition brought together the 115 world's top drone pilots to compete for the coveted title of world champion. The event, which was part of the World Drone Festa, demonstrated Korea's mastery of drones, especially during its impressive opening and closing ceremonies.

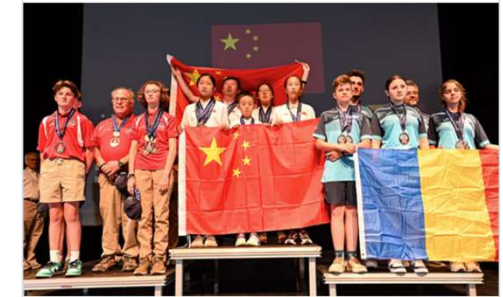

Travel Insurance for FAI Officials and Elected Office Holders

Personal Accident and Travel Insurance including Medical Expenses Cover

(Information as of 1st May 2023)

FAI have decided to entrust Marsh, a legally authorised broker to transact insurance business to procure an open travel insurance policy to FAI, which the latter makes available the benefit of said policy. There is no obligation to use the policy.

Such insurance covers "Elected Office Holders" (Commission Presidents, Bureau Members, Executive Board members, Staff) while they are travelling 'on duty for FAI' since several years. As of 1st April 2022 the policy has been extended to also cover elected officials (judges, juries, event director and team etc).

This scheme is in place for all **sanctioned FAI category 1-events**; and it includes pre-events/test-events if one mentions the 'main sanctioned event' in the survey. Renewal of the policy has been completed and cover is in place from **1 April 2023 – 31 March 2024**.

The following survey supports a self-registration-scheme which one should fill in prior to leaving home. Data is not shared with insurance company, nor is it monitored by FAI Secretariat.

The survey is self-explanatory. Important: For those travelling more than once during a year, you must declare your travel intentions each time you travel. Each event (meeting, sanctioned event etc) is treated individually.

Annex: FAI-GC-2023-Annex-09.3.2-Statutes-Working-Group-ToR (2013_final)

According to FAI Statute 5.4.2.1, the Statutes and By-Laws Working Group is a Permanent Working Group of the FAI General Conference established in 2004 by the 97th FAI General Conference.

From the Terms of Reference: *The Statutes Working Group shall consist of 5 elected members including the Working Group Chairman. In addition, to ensure good liaison and communication between the Statutes Working Group and the Executive Board, the FAI President shall appoint an Executive Director as an additional non-voting member.*

Nominations for the post of Chairman and members of the Working Group shall be made by the FAI President. The General Conference may nominate additional candidates for the positions of Chairman and members. The Chairman and the members of the Working Group shall be elected, in two separate votes, by the General Conference.

CASI: FORMALITIES (STATUTES 5.2.3.2.7.1 AND 5.2.3.2.8)

"The Commission shall consist of:

– Eleven Active Members, each with one vote, to be elected by the General Conference. Prior to the election, Active Members shall declare the principal, and if desired alternate representatives who will be designated if the Member is elected...

"Annually, on an alternating basis, five or six of the members of the Air Sport General Commission elected under 5.2.3.2.7.1. above shall go out of office, beginning with six members in 2017. Elections shall be by secret ballot, either written or electronic...

Elected in 2021 and their two year-term term is ending in 2023:

- **BRA, FRA, GBR, GER, HKG, SUI.**

These countries are required to stand-down in GC 2023.

Elected in 2022 and their two year-term term is ending in 2024:
