



ENTRY FEES AND LOGISTICS


The goal of the organization is to ensure two category 1 competitions for the Advanced and Intermediate category.

Based on the number of competitors from the last competitions, we expect a number of 30 pilots in the Advanced class and 15 in the Intermediate class.

The offer to organize these competitions is conditional on having a minimum of 45 competitors in total, and if this value is not met, we will not organize any of the events.

If the Intermediate class competition does not meet the conditions to be a category 1 event, we are willing to organize a category 2 competition.

BUCHAREST AREA WEATHER



September is a moderately warm month in Bucharest, Romania, with temperature in the range of an average low of 11.1°C(52°F) and an average high of 24.6°C (76.3°F).

The average length of the day in Bucharest is 12.5h.

The average relative humidity in Bucharest is 71%.
