The Romanian Aeroclub is a flight school and Air Sports Organisation for young people, offering free training for powered flight, gliding and parachuting.



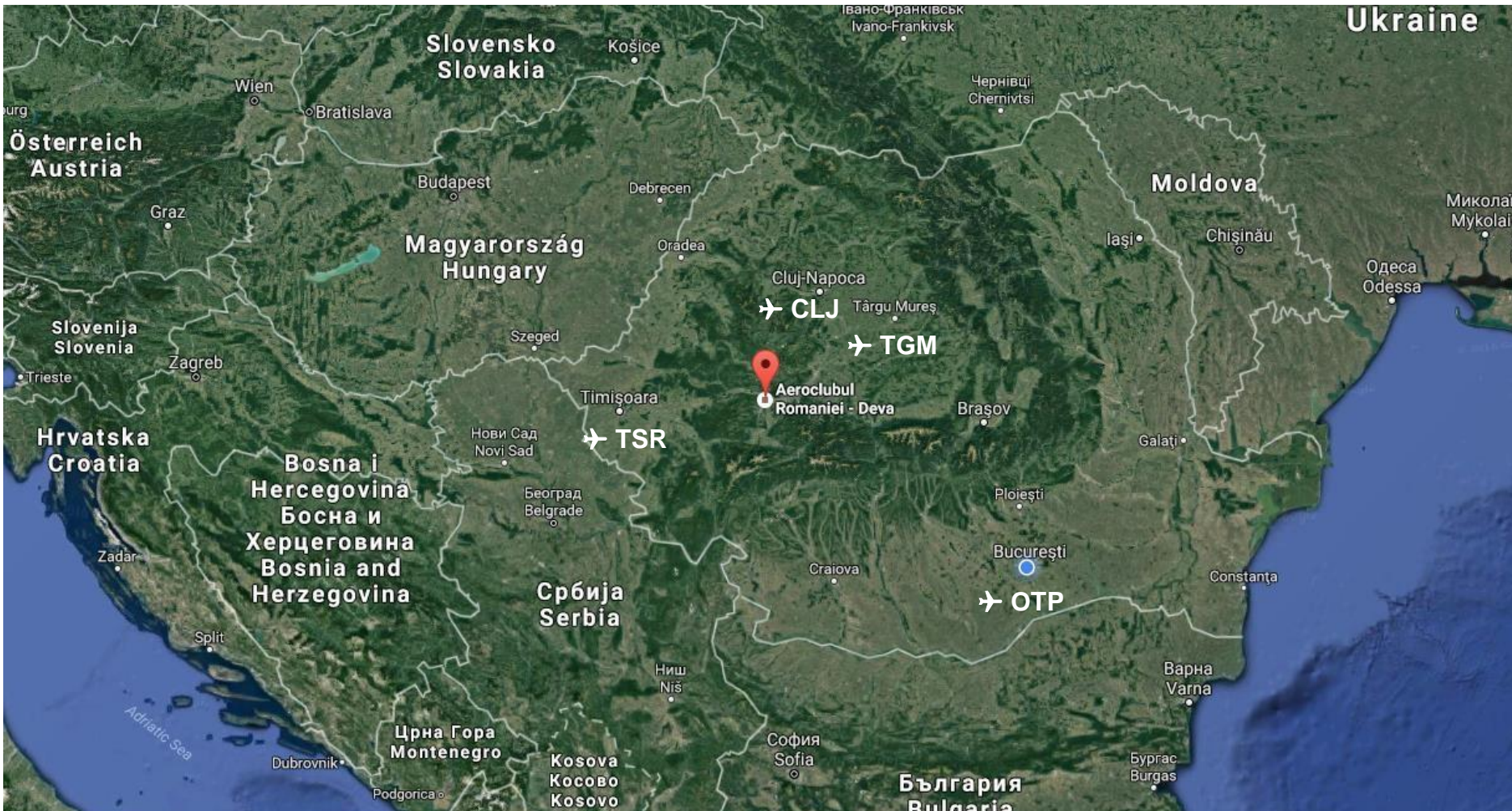
Aerobatic flight is a tradition for Romanian Aeroclub, our pilots being present at numerous Championships in the World.

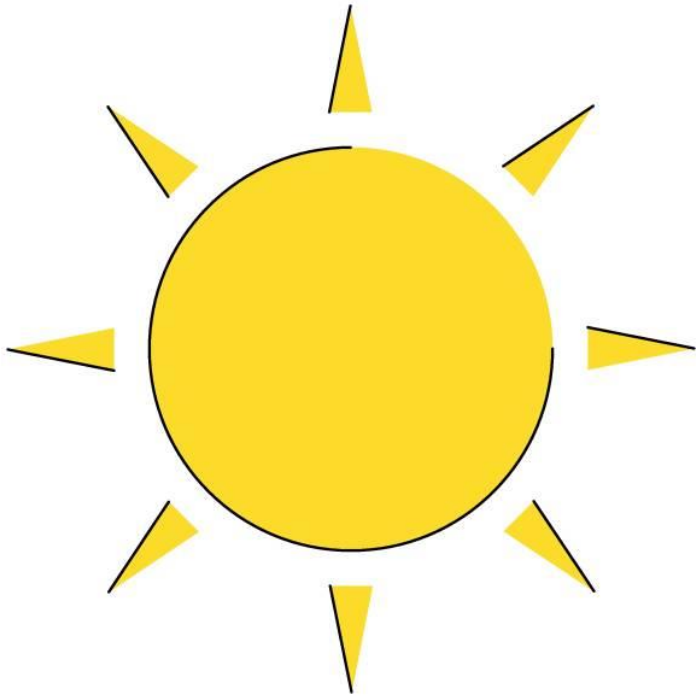

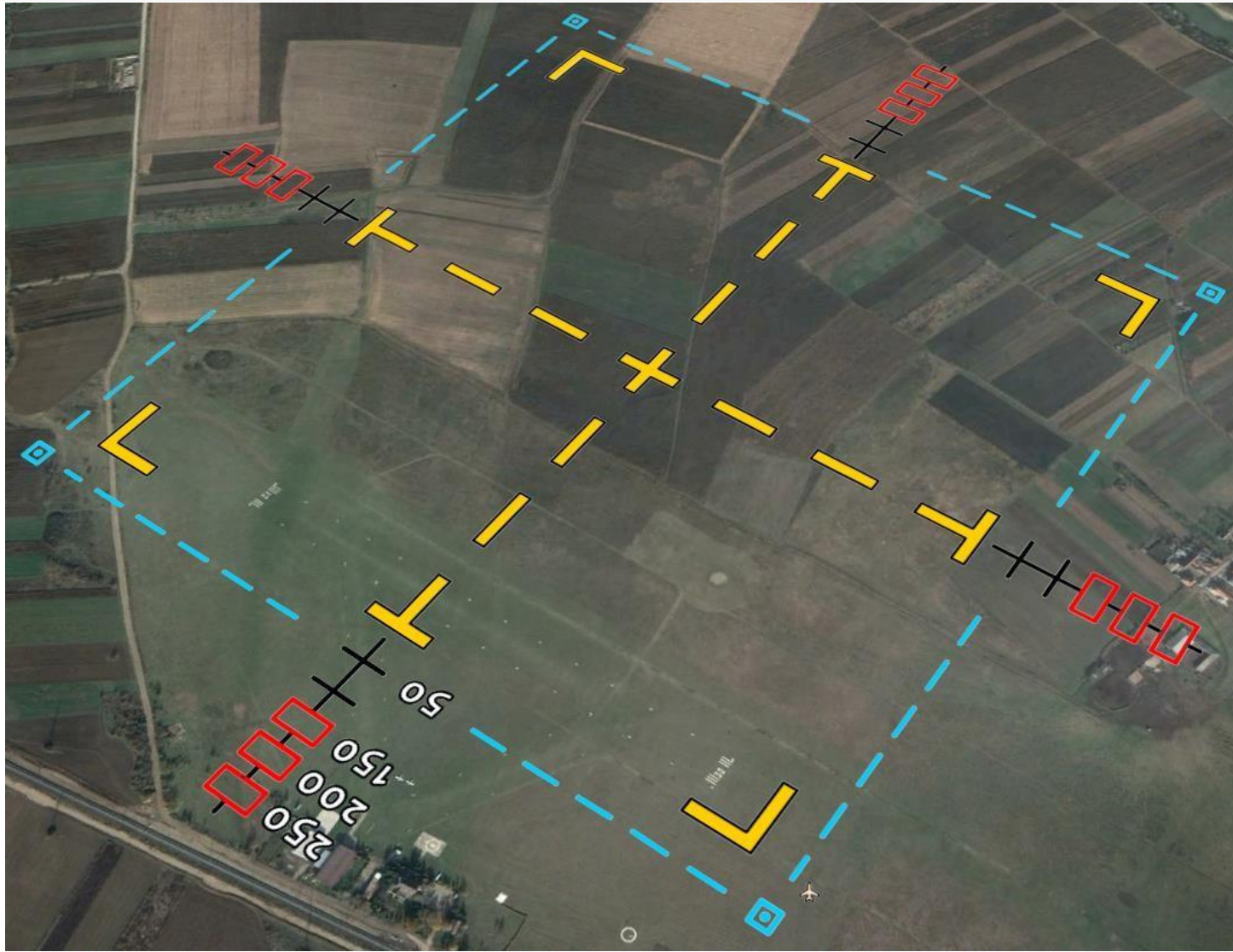

Box for competition



Entry fees

- **competitors - EUR 1850**
- **other team members and observers - EUR 1600**
- The entry fees cover:
 - fuel and oil for competition flights
 - shared accommodation – double room
 - breakfast, lunch and dinner
 - transport between airfield and accommodation places
 - official and social functions
 - sanction fee of 200 euro per competitor
 - programs arranged by the organizer

Additional notes from the organizer:

1. For those participants who do not request accommodation, a discount is made from the participation fee in the amount of 350 Euros. In this case, the organizer cannot provide transport to the airport and to the accommodation unit.

2. For those participants who choose to occupy a single room, an additional fee of 350 Euros will be charged.

Details and conditions

- The judging panel to be comprised of 5 (five) judges with one assistant each, with a scoring chief judge. Maybe some of the assistants could be local people
- The standard 3-person FAI jury, with one or two present on-site and other/s available via telephone/internet application
- Minimum 20 competitors from at least 5 countries
Confirmed at least 1 month prior the competition

Other activities



The Prislop Monastery

Prislop Monastery is situated in one of the most picturesque regions of our country. From Hateg on the south opens the great depression of Hateg or "Hateg" the cradle of the Roman people, which extends to the foot of Retezat Mountains.

Located in a clearing, elevation 640 m, Prislop Monastery is surrounded by hills that descend in gentle slopes to near monument.



The Corvin Castle
