1. No entry fee is required for CIVA appointed Officials.

IV. FEES AND PAYMENT DETAILS

1. The entry fee does not include the competitors expenses of the accommodation, meals nor the towing service.
2. Payment of the registration fee must be done via bank-transfer.
3. Deadline of entry fee payment is 15th June 2020.
4. If payment is made later than 15th June 2020 or at the contest site, an additional 150 EUR will be charged.
5. Any payments charges (transfer costs etc.) should to be paid by the participant.
6. In the case of entry fee refunds the refunded amount will be reduced by any bank fees or charges that apply to the Organizer.
7. If a competitor is disqualified from the event according to FAI Sporting Code no entry fee will be refunded.
8. The entry fee covers farewell party (competitors and team members).

V. REGULATIONS

1. The FAI 23rd WGAC & 11th WAGAC 2020 will be conducted according to the following rules:
 - FAI Sporting Code – General Section,
 - FAI Sporting Code – Section 6, Part 2,
 - Flight Rules published by the Civil Aviation Authorities of Poland, local regulations.
2. The official languages during the FAI 23rd WGAC & 11th WAGAC 2020 are Polish and English. The language of all communications and briefings is English.
3. All FAI member NACs (National Airsport Control such as National Aeroclub etc.) may be represented at the WGAC2020 / WAGAC2020 by the team and/or an individual competitor/observer.
4. The competitors must be members of NACs.
5. Only the entries submitted by NACs will be accepted.
6. All competitors have to be holders of:
 - valid glider pilot's license with an aerobatic extension according to competitor's national legislation,
 - valid FAI sporting license,
 - valid medical certificate,
 - valid personal insurance policy.
7. All participating glider aircrafts must satisfy the performance criteria essential for competition flights in the advanced/unlimited aerobatic category.
8. A valid aerobatic certificate of airworthiness or equivalent document issued by the competent aviation authority of the participant's country must be produced to the organizers for every contest glider aircraft (FAI Sporting Code Section 6 1.2.7.1).
9. All participating aircrafts must have the Certificate of Insurance against Third Party Liability covering a minimum limit according to EU 785/2004, valid for The Republic of Poland for the period of staying there.
10. Hangar space for competing gliders will be available free of charge for the period of the Championships.

VI. ACCOMMODATION

1. Camping

Campsite with a capacity of 100+ people is located at the Leszno Airfield area. The area is partially wooded, fenced, campsite equipped with electric plugs boxes (230V and 400V), communal area with showers, WC, fully equipped kitchen.
