- Big airfield to support safe massive take offs & landings

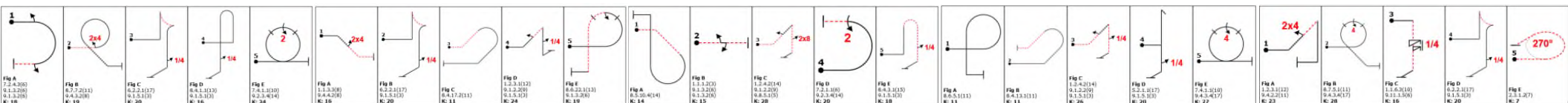


Aerobatic Box Location



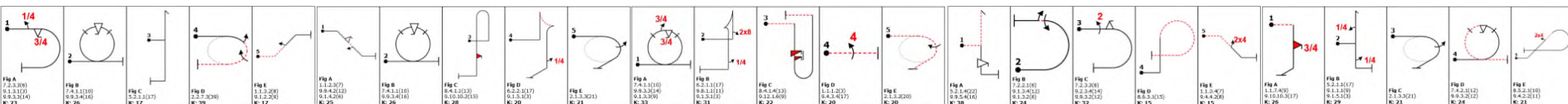
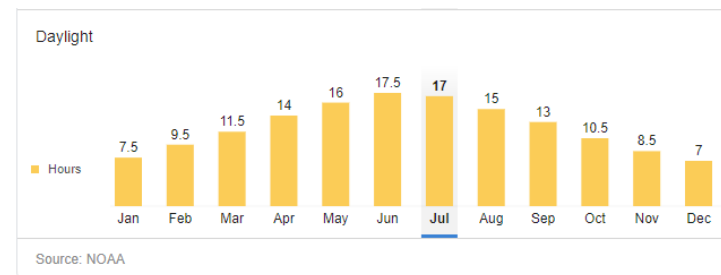
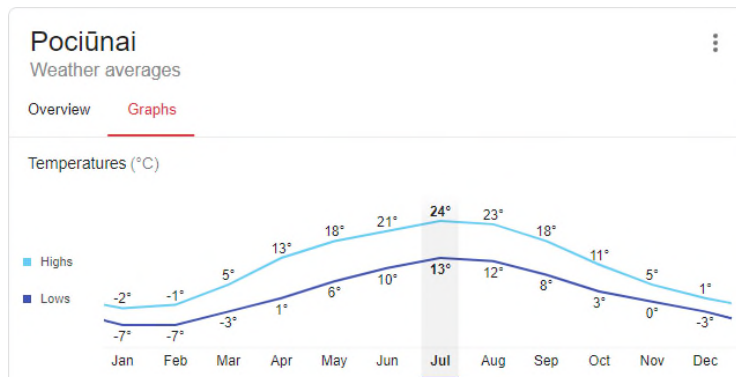

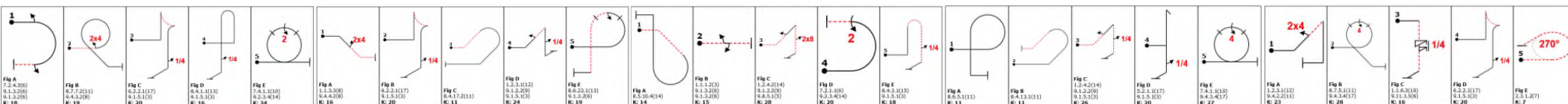
Expected Meteorological Conditions

- Average temperature in July – 24 °C / 13 °C (High / Low)
- Long daylight:
 - Sunrise – 5:26 AM (July 27th) to 5:44 AM (August 6th)
 - Sunset – 9:33 PM (July 27th) to 9:15 PM (August 6th)



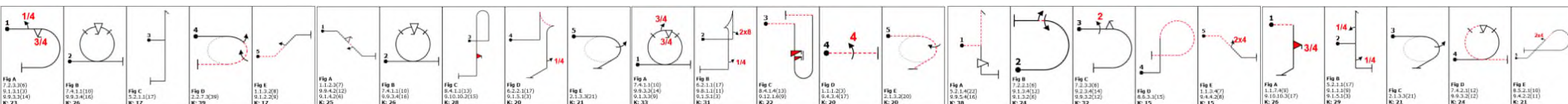
Local Amenities

- Jury meeting room - in Club building
- Briefing room - in hangar
- LAK factory and Company Termikas for repair services next to airfield
- Bar – Restaurant
- Toilets, wash and shower rooms – in main buildings and mobile units
- Free WiFi in all area
- Car parking at the glider parking and camping area
- Emergency – ambulance, fire service, safeguards will be on full time standby (within 10 min. arrival from town Prienai)



Accommodation

- At the airfield:
 - Camping with sanitary and electricity for up to 100 caravans and tents
 - 3 club houses for 8 persons each
 - 5 private houses for rent (4-5 persons)
- Birstonas city in 15 km (15 min drive):
 - Hotels

- Vilnius / EYVI / VNO - 110 km, 1 h 30 min drive by car



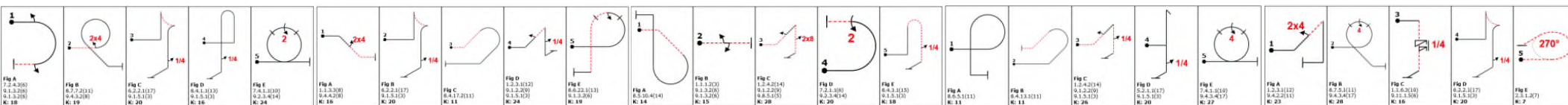
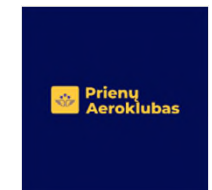
